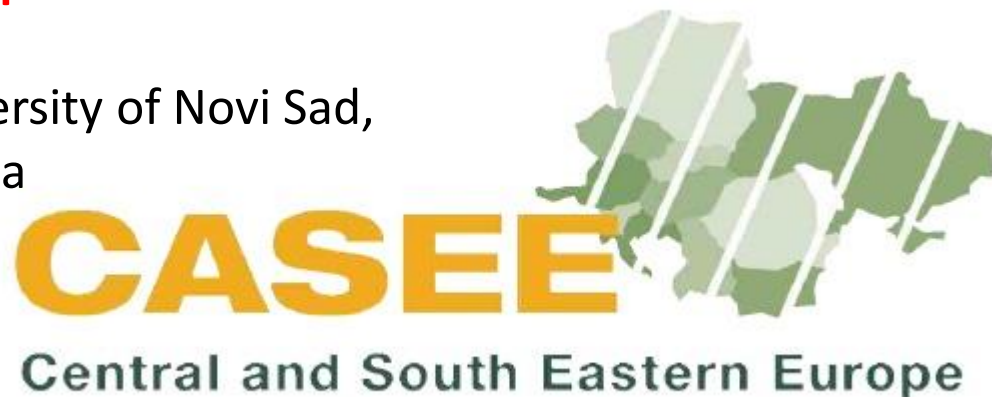

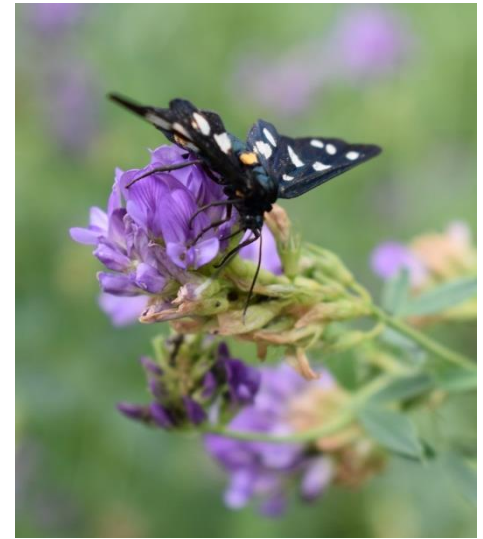
1. Experimental field for fruitgrowing
